ASCO's recently released its Academic Year 2015-2016 Annual Faculty Data Report. The total number of 1.0 FTE faculty at the 21 member institutions enrolling students during 2015-2016 increased 0.6\% compared with the previous year, from 712 to 716 . In addition, $46.4 \%$ of 1.0 FTE faculty members are male and $53.6 \%$ are female. The number of male 1.0 FTE faculty members decreased $1.8 \%$, and the number of 1.0 FTE female faculty members increased $2.7 \%$. The report was made available to the deans and presidents of ASCO's member schools and colleges in November 2016.
