### **Clinical Skills Pre-Conference, Thursday, Sept. 20 - Friday, Sept. 21**

The Clinical Skills program provides 12 hours of continuing education and includes both hands-on and lecture style presentations. It offers three different levels which run concurrently and cannot be taken simultaneously.

- **Skills Level I** - An introduction to anatomy and physiology in relation to traumatic brain injury rehabilitative care, with a specific focus on the principles and application of Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation.
- **Skills Level II** - Provides advanced applications of general rehabilitation and Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation.
- **Advanced NORA Symposium** - Includes two different speakers/topics:
  - Lyme Disease - Leading experts will discuss a multidisciplinary approach and provide case studies regarding the management and rehabilitation of patients diagnosed with Lyme disease
  - Nutrition - Topics covered include neurobiological, genomic and neuro-immune testing and treatment modalities for traumatic brain injury and neuro-immune syndromes.

### **General Conference, Friday, Sept. 21 - Sunday, Sept. 23**

The NORA General Conference offers up to 14 additional hours of continuing education for Doctors of Optometry and allied professionals.
