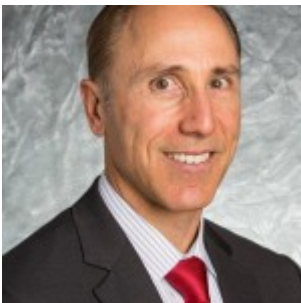




*Dr. Gregory S. Moore*
